## Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Race, Color or National Origin Discrimination

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination based on race, color, or national origin in programs or activities that receive federal financial assistance. Title VI states that:

Honoring America's Warriors operates its programs without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
